Is the Franklin Turkey Trot still happening?

Yes, but it will look a little different this year. Runners can run any time between November 22 and November 28.

Why is there a virtual option in 2020?

Due to the current Massachusetts restrictions on mass gatherings during the COVID-19 pandemic, we have decided to host a virtual event this year. Our goal is to give all loyal past participants and friends the opportunity to still run the Turkey Trot together, but safely apart.
