# Questions/Answers

**Q. How many times a week can I come?**

A. You may come once a week.

**Q. When do the new hours start?**

A. Starting October 18

**Q. Can I just show up for indoor shopping?**

A. No, you must make an appointment. **No walk-ins will be accommodated.**

**Q. How do I make an appointment**

**Q. Can I still do drive-up pickup?**

A. Yes, you can choose one or the other. You can alternate weekly, if you like.

**Q. How many people can shop inside with me?**

A. Please only bring yourself for shopping. If you need to bring other family members, they can either wait in the car, or you should come for drive-up distribution.

**Q. Can I still pick up for other people?**

A. Yes, at curbside distribution.

**Q. What will my choices be?**

A. During indoor shopping you may choose your produce, shelf-stable items and protein. There will be a two-bag limit of shelf-stable items and we will still provide kids' bags. Drive-up distribution will remain the same as it has been.

**Q. What safety precautions are you taking?**

A. We are limiting the amount of people in The Pantry at one time. Masks and hand sanitizer are required (we will provide).
